

Guidelines of Yang Zong-Wei's Scholarship for Volunteers Entrusted to National Changhua University of Education

Approved at Administrative Meeting on Oct.1, 2008
Amended and Approved at Administrative Meeting on Mar.9, 2011

1. Purpose: The Scholarship is funded and entrusted by Mr. Yang Zong-Wei to encourage students of our university to involve voluntary services and make contributions to their school and society. The Guidelines was regulated by the University in this regard.
2. Target: All undergraduate and postgraduate students of the University excluding students of College of Extension Education.
3. Quota: A total of two students are granted per semester.
4. Amount: Each awarded student is granted NT\$5,000 per semester.
5. Eligibility:
 - 5.1 The students who served as counseling volunteers inside and outside the University in the last semester; or have been helping gay people / the disadvantages and their organizations with outstanding performance that was proved by the organization they work for.
 - 5.2 An applicant's academic record of last semester shall be all passed with a conduct grade scored 82 points or above.
 - 5.3 Those who are not awarded Scholarship of Service Contribution (服務奉獻獎學金) by the University.
6. Dates and Location for Application: applications shall be submitted to Office of Student Affairs during October 1 to 31 in the first semester; and March 1 to 31 in the second semester.
7. Procedure: the following documents shall be attached when applying:
 - a) Application Form;
 - b) Supporting evidence of voluntary services;
 - c) Recommendation from any of the faculty of the University;
 - d) Transcript of the last semester;
 - e) Photocopy of Student ID.
8. Criteria of Evaluation:
 - 8.1 One student is granted under each of the two categories below:
 - a) Counseling Volunteer;
 - b) The students who have helped gay people / the disadvantages and their organizations (those help gay people/ organizations will be prioritized).
 - 8.2 If there is no applicant under any of these two categories, the quota can be shared between these two.
9. Grant: the awarded students will be granted scholarship by the University on behalf of the funder after evaluation. The results will be mailed to the funder.
10. This scholarship program shall be implemented for 25 years onwards started from the first semester of academic year 2008 after being ratified.
11. The Guidelines shall go into effect after being approved by Administrative Meeting and ratified by President. The same procedure shall be applied to the amendments likewise.
