

Scholarships for Outstanding Students of National Changhua University of Education

1. The Guidelines was regulated pursuant to MOE's instructions of Subsidies for College Students' Study(大學院校辦理學生就學補助原則)to award outstanding students while promoting academic cultivation of excellence. The Guidelines contains the implementations of Outstanding Performance Scholarship (學行優良獎學金), Distinguished Talent Scholarship (傑出才能獎學金),and Service Contribution Scholarship (服務奉獻獎學金).

2. Target and Method of Grants:

2.1 Outstanding Performance Scholarship (學行優良獎學金)

A. Eligibility:

- 1) The undergraduate students of our university who are qualified to graduate earlier than others with excellent academic performance (students on graduation extension are excluded) as at least 9 credits in the last semester are acquired (those graduate earlier than others are excluded) while those in their fourth year shall acquire at least 8 credits and both of the two groups shall gain 82 points or above for their conduct score. Top three eligible students with the best average grade in each class will be awarded.
- 2) The average grade of students will be calculated to the second decimal place. If there is a tie in average grade, the candidates will be prioritized by their conduct scores. If there is still a tie in both grades between candidates, they will all be granted.
- 3) The students who graduate earlier than others; or transfer from other department in this semester shall be included in the quota of grant in their class.

B. Amount: The student in the first place shall be granted NT\$8,000;

The student in the second place shall be granted NT\$6,000;

The student in the third place shall be granted NT\$4,000.

C. Grant of the scholarship will be implemented once every semester within four weeks after the semester commences. The list of candidates provided by Office of Academic Affairs shall be evaluated and submitted by Office of Student Affairs to President for ratification.

2.2 Distinguished Talent Scholarship (傑出才能獎學金)

A. Eligibility: the students or a team of students of our university who performed brilliantly in a competition of sports, music, fine arts, literature, theater, dance, local art, or crafts in the last semester with an average grade of 60 points or above as well as conduct score of 82 points or above without any record of demerit (not applied to the students awarded as a team) shall meet one of the following requirements to submit their applications to Office of Student Affairs:

Category I:

- 1) Representing Taiwan to attend an international competition and have won a prize as top sixteen; or representing our university to attend an international competition and having won a prize as top six;
- 2) Representing our university to attend a national competition and having won the first prize or Distinguished Award (特優);
- 3) Representing our university to attend a competition organized by MOE or Chinese Taipei University Sports Federation (CTUSF) and having won the first prize.

Category II:

- 1) Representing our university to attend an national competition and having won the second or third prize or Excellent Award (優等);
- 2) Representing our university to attend a competition organized by MOE or CTUSF and having won the second or third prize.

Category III:

- 1) Representing our university to attend a competition outside the campus (an inter-college one or non-national one) and having won one of the top three prizes or Distinguished Award/ Excellent Award.
- 2) Having been selected as a member of a national team for international competitions.

A representative above shall apply for participating in a competition on behalf of our university and being approved by President; or have been permitted by the university before application; or have applied for attending activities outside the school and being permitted by Office of Student Affairs with supporting documents.

B. Amount:

- 1) Contest Team: Those qualified under Category I shall be granted NT\$6,000;
Those qualified under Category II shall be granted NT\$4,000;
Those qualified under Category III shall be granted NT\$2,000;
- 2) Individual Contestant: Those qualified under Category I shall be granted NT\$3,000;
Those qualified under Category II shall be granted NT\$2,000;
Those qualified under Category III shall be granted NT\$1,000;
- 3) Contest Group: The amount of grant for the competitions with contestants/ contest teams less than 6 will be cut in half.

C. The scholarship is open to application during March and October of every year. If an applicant has won several prizes, she/ he shall file an application for one of the prizes.

D. Applicants shall fill out an application form and attach relevant documents (competition documents, photocopy of the competition program, certificate of prizes, and application form) and submit them to Office of Student Affairs for evaluation and being ratified by President.

E. New graduates shall submit application before graduation for exclusive evaluation.

2.3 Service Contribution Scholarship (服務奉獻獎學金)

A. Eligibility: The students of our university who involved themselves in service work at school clubs inside and outside the campus with excellent performance have acquired an average academic grade of 60 points or above as well as conduct score of 82 points or above in the last semester without any record of demerit and meet one of the following requirements shall submit their applications to Office of Student Affairs:

- 1) Being assigned or elected as a Chief Officer of Student Association or in a higher position; or as a Deputy Chair of a school club or academic department association or in a higher position; or as a leader of a service team in the last semester who performed well and being recommended by Extracurricular Activity Section and an instructor. A maximum of 10 students shall be recommended once in an academic year.
- 2) Being a volunteer inside and outside the school for a total of 96 hours or more in the last semester and being recommended by the service unit they worked for. The service hours required by programs studied and financial aids for disadvantaged students; requirements of graduation or the verified hours of programs studied shall not be included. A maximum of 10 students shall be recommended once in an academic year.
- 3) Their club was awarded Excellent Award or above by the school or National Club Evaluation (全國社團評鑑).

B. Amount: 1) the cadre and volunteers of a club shall be granted NT\$5,000 each;

- 2) The club awarded Distinguished Award by the university shall be granted NT\$5,000 while those awarded Excellent Award shall be granted NT\$3,000 each; the club awarded Distinguished Award by National Club Evaluation shall be granted NT\$10,000 while those awarded Excellent Award shall be granted

NT\$5,000 each.

C. The scholarship is open to application during October of every year.

D. Applications shall be evaluated and submitted by Office of Student Affairs to President for ratification.

3. The Scholarships are funded by relevant annual budgets. The students who have been granted the scholarship funded by the budgets of our university shall not apply for this scholarship based on the same reason again.
4. The Guidelines shall go into effect after being approved by Administrative Meeting and ratified by President. The same procedure shall be applied to the amendments likewise.
