

## **Guidelines of Scholarship for Indigent Students Entrusted to National Changhua University of Education**

Amended and Approved at Administrative Meeting on Mar.9, 2011

1. Purpose: The Guidelines for applying for the scholarship which was entrusted to the University was regulated for encouraging outstanding indigent students of our university to concentrate on their study.
2. Target: All indigent undergraduate and postgraduate students of the University.
3. Quota: A total of five students for each semester. At least one student from Department of Industrial Education and Technology shall be awarded.
4. Amount: Each awarded student is granted NT\$10,000 per semester.
5. Eligibility:
  - 5.1 An applicant's average grade gained in the last semester shall be 80 points or above; and conduct grade shall be scored 82 points or above.
  - 5.2 Qualified as an indigent student.
  - 5.3 An applicant shall not be granted other scholarships entrusted to the University.
6. Dates and Location for Application: applications shall be submitted to Office of Student Affairs during October 1 to 31 in the first semester; and March 1 to 31 in the second semester.
7. Procedure: the following documents shall be attached when applying:
  - a) Application Form;
  - b) Transcript of the last semester;
  - c) Photocopy of Student ID;
  - d) Certificate of Indigent Status or the proof provided by student's advisor.
8. Evaluation: evaluation procedure will be carried out by Office of Student Affairs pursuant to Article 2, 3 and 5 of the Guidelines. Applicants will be prioritized by their academic records. If there is a tie in average grade, the applicant with a higher conduct score will be considered. The criteria of academic grade between different colleges will be taken into account during the process.
9. Grant: the awarded students will be granted scholarship by the University on behalf of the donator after evaluation. The results will be mailed to the donator.
10. This scholarship program shall be implemented for 4 years onwards started from the second semester of academic year 2010 after being ratified.
11. The Guidelines shall go into effect after being approved by Administrative Meeting and ratified by President. The same procedure shall be applied to the amendments likewise.
