

Regulations for Motorcycle and Bicycle Management at National Changhua University of Education

Approved at the Administrative Meeting on May10, 2006

1. The Regulations was formulated to ensure the safety and security of campus transportation and environment as well as to manage students' motorcycles and bicycles in an effective way.
2. A Vehicle ID issued by our university shall be attached on the motorcycles and bicycles when being ridden by students to get in and out of the campus otherwise the student will be punished as an violator.
3. One Vehicle ID for one type of vehicle shall be applied for by one individual student pursuant to the relevant regulations of Guidance and Counseling Section, Office of Student Affairs in the beginning of each academic year.
4. The motorcycles that students are riding shall be slowed down to 15 km/hr. when entering Jin-De Campus from west gate. Motorcycles and bicycles are strictly forbidden in entering pedestrian areas, the driveway for the disables, college green and sports fields. Motorcycles without a permit shall not enter accommodation areas.
5. All vehicles shall be parked in the designated area in an orderly way otherwise the student will be punished as a violator.
6. All parking areas at our university are provided as spaces for parking vehicles. The school shall not be responsibilities for any loss, storage or damage.
7. Procedure of handling violations:
 1. The owner of vehicle who violates the Regulations shall be given a ticket while the vehicle shall be locked and taken pictures as evidence.
 2. The owners shall bring the ticket with them and pay NT\$ 200 for unlocking their vehicles; or their vehicles will be unlocked after one week.
 3. If any students of our school have violated against the regulations for three times in the same semester, their Vehicle ID and parking rights in that academic year shall be cancelled.
 4. The list of violators will be sent to Deans of each academic department, violator's advisor and military training instructor for them to give guidance individually.
8. All payments for unlocking vehicles will be collected and used as University Fund.
9. The Regulations shall go into effect after being approved by Administrative Meeting and ratified by President. The same procedure shall be applied to the amendments likewise.
