

Guidelines of Fellowship for Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Postgraduate Students at National Changhua University of Education

Approved at Administrative Meeting on Jun.1, 2011

Approved at Administrative Meeting on Sep.12, 2012

1. The Guidelines was regulated pursuant to MOE Subsidized Fellowship for Outstanding Overseas Compatriot Students at Graduate Schools (教育部補助大學校院設置研究所優秀僑生獎學金作業要點) for encouraging outstanding overseas compatriot students to study at the graduate schools of our university.
2. Eligibility:
 - 2.1 The overseas compatriot students who are taking Master's or doctoral program sat graduate schools of our university in line with Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Compatriot Students in Taiwan (through both routes of assignment and entrance exam); and those who come from Hong Kong or Macao enrolled at the graduate schools in line with Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan.
 - 2.2 The overseas compatriot students with student status at graduate schools of our university who have completed the study of at least one subject (dissertation instruction excluded) for one semester and gained an average grade of 85 points or above as well as a conduct score of 82 points or above in the last semester.
 - 2.3 An applicant shall not be granted any other scholarships or financial aids provided by any public sectors or schools.
3. Quota: the number of awarded students for each academic year shall be decided and allocated by the actual number of enrolled students at graduate schools of our university after the total amount of fellowship of that academic year is ratified by MOE.
4. Application Procedure: the overseas compatriot students who apply for this Fellowship (hereinafter referred to as the Applicants) shall submit their applications within the application period announced by Office of Student Affairs after each semester commences.
5. Grant: an amount of not less than NT\$ 10,000 shall be provided monthly as the Fellowship after being approved each semester. Those awarded students who are in their last year of study will receive the grant until the month they graduate. If an awarded overseas compatriot student has suspended or withdrawn from school, he/she shall stop receiving the grant from the following month after the situation occurs.
6. One copy for each of the following documents shall be attached when applying:
 - a) Application Form;
 - b) Photocopy of Student ID;
 - c) Transcript;
 - d) Recommendation from applicant's Instructor.
7. Evaluation Procedure: a)An Evaluation Team will be constituted by Dean of Academic Affairs, Chief of Guidance and Counseling Section, and Chief of Extracurricular Activities Section to select candidates and submit the result to President for approval. b) Directors or Chief Officers of the department applicants studying at shall be invited to attend evaluation meetings.
8. If there is any matter not being covered by the Guidelines, it shall be governed by the relevant regulations of Ministry of Education as well as our university.
9. The Guidelines shall go into effect after being approved by Administrative Meeting and ratified by President. The same procedure shall be applied to the amendments likewise.
