

Regulations for Demerit Cancellation at National Changhua University of Education

Approved at the Administrative Meeting on May 9, 2007

Article 1 The Regulations was formulated to encourage students to self-reflect on their misconduct as well as to foster their awareness of citizenship in which the essence of education is emphasized.

Article 2 The students who regret violating regulations of the school and have been punished by a penalty at the level lower than a major demerit while having filed an application are eligible for demerit cancellation.

Article 3 The students who have been punished shall file an application for demerit cancellation at Guidance and Counseling Section (GCS) of Office of Student Affairs within half a year since the day when their penalty is confirmed. Those students are requested to provide labor services under GCS's guidance after their applications are approved by their Class Advisors, Chief Advisors and Deans.

Article 4 Labor Service here refers to maintaining environment of campus and other appropriate works and shall be carried out in the following ways:

1. Those who are punished by one Reprimand shall provide a 10-hour labor service; those who are punished by one Minor Demerit shall provide a 30-hour labor service; and so forth. The labor service above shall be carried out for at most 4 hours a day.
2. The content of labor service shall be designated and followed up by GCS and the advisor of the punished student.
3. Labor service shall be completed within half a year after being designated. The deadline of labor service implementation for any special case shall be assessed and set by Student Affairs Meeting.

Article 5 The punishment record will be removed after a demerit has been successfully cancelled. Nonetheless student's conduct score will not be changed or added a note.

Article 6 The punishment record will not be removed if the student fails to achieve that before graduation.

Article 7 The Regulations shall go into effect after being approved by Administrative Meeting and ratified by President. The same procedure shall be applied to the amendments likewise.
